There was a meeting of the Bay State Council of Divers at the clubhouse on Tuesday, May 3rd. There were around a dozen and one-half people from the dive community present. Matthew Lawrence and Deborah Marx from the Stellwagen Bank Marine Sancxtuary attended and presented an overview of the status of the Sanctuary Management Plan Review process. Also there was a discussion on scuba divers in New England waters. That is, the diminishing numbers of divers. Angelo Correnti spoke with Paul Adler at the Sea Rover's Show. Paul is involved with the Oceans for Youth Foundation, a group which encourages underwater education for youth. The Foundation has a DVD available to be shown to kids to encourage interest in our oceans.

The pool schedule for the summer was not available for the newsletter so there is nothing in the calendar.

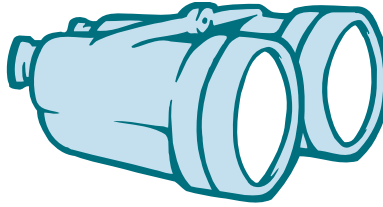
