MARINE FISHERIES ADVISORY — DELAY IN MAILING OF NON-COMMERCIAL LOBSTER PERMIT RENEWAL

"There has been a delay in the printing and mailing of non-commercial lobster permit renewals this year due to the addition of a reporting requirement and supporting harvest map on the annual catch report. *The Division of Marine Fisheries (Marine Fisheries)* anticipates that renewals for 2008 will be mailed by the end of February 2008."

"Non-commercial lobster permits for 2007 will remain valid until March 31, 2008. Note, MA residents can renew permits for 2008 online at: www.mass.gov/marinefisheries"
