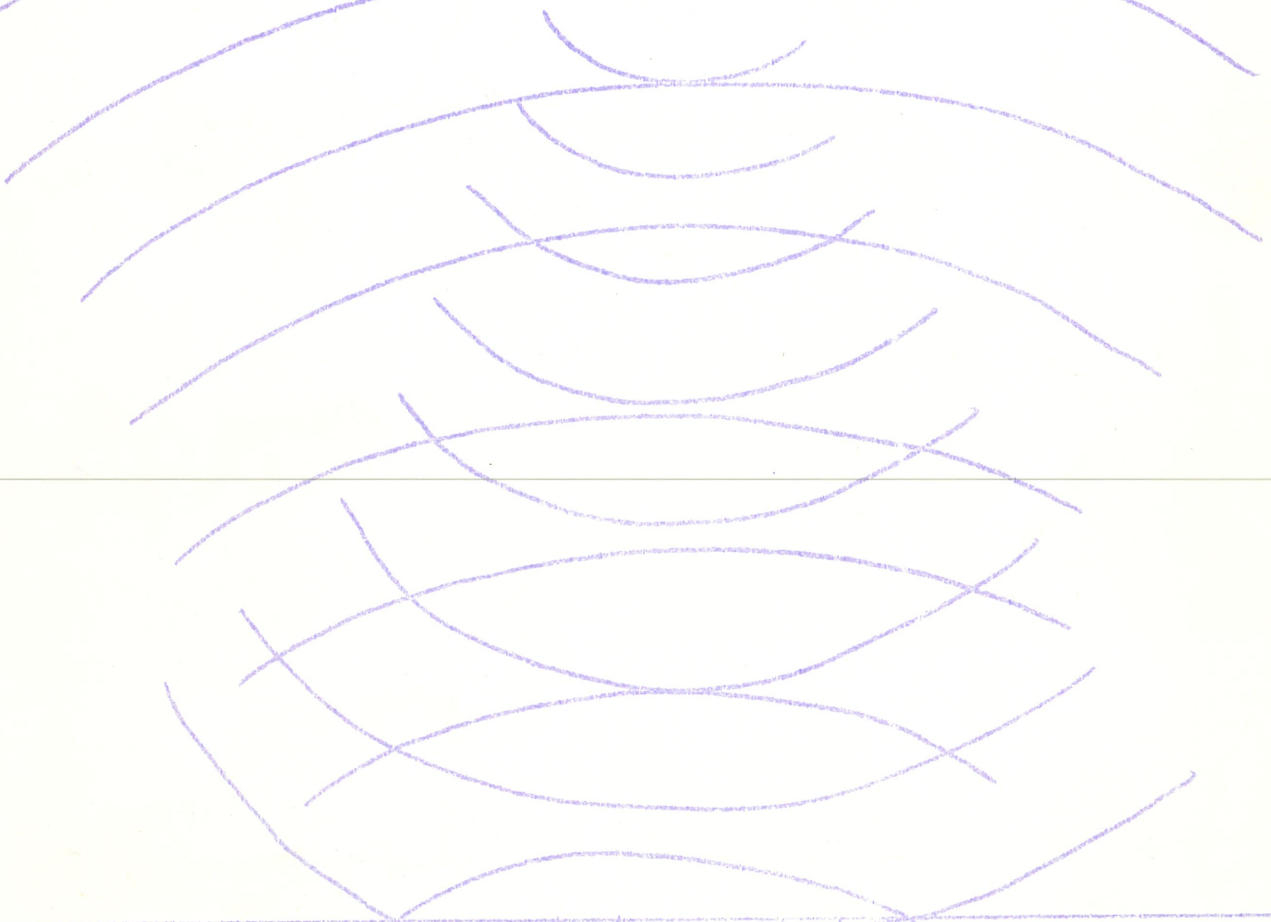

* WRECK DIVING & THE CHESTER A. POLLING *

TO MANY DIVERS ONE OF THE MOST INTRIGING AND CHALLENGING FORMS OF SPORT DIVING IS WRECK DIVING. THEIR DREAM COME TRUE MIGHT BE A NEW WRECK ONE WITH PLEANTY OF GOODIES, LOTS OF BRASS, EASY TO LOCATE, IN PERFECT CONDITION, AND A "VIRGIN WRECK."

THIS MIGHT BE A GOOD DESCRIPTION OF THE INFAMOUS WRECK, CHESTER A. POLLING. SHE IS A 1,546 TON, 280 FT. COASTAL TANKER. ON JAN. 10, 1977 IN A VIOLENT WINTER STORM TYPICAL OF THE NORTHEAST SHE BROKE IN TWO OFF OF EAST POINT, GLOUCESTER. HER STERS HALF EVENTUALLY CAME TO REST UPRIGHT IN 80 FT. OF WATER, 1,000 YDS. SOUTH OF EASTERN POINT AND IS PRESENTLY MARKED BY A RED NUN BUOY. HER DECKS HOLD MANY INTERESTING "TREASURES" FOR WRECK DIVERS, ALONG WITH GREAT SHOTS FOR THE UNDER-WATER PHOTOGRAPHER.

THOUGH THE EXTERIOR HULL AND EXPOSED DECKS OF THE SHIP APPEAR TO BE IN PERFECT CONDITION, EVEN A SIMPLE DIVE TO DECKS HAS IT'S HAZARDS; HEAVY DOCKING LINES, GUARD RAIL CHAINS AND HOSES POSE A GREAT DANGER TO THE UNAWARE DIVER. THE DEPTH ALONE, 65 TO 70 FT. CAN PROVE TO BE A PROBLEM WITH DECOMPRESSION IF YOU USE DOUBLES OR DO MORE THAN ONE DIVE. SURFACE CURRENTS AND SEA CONDITIONS IN THE AREA OFF EASTERN POINT CAN BE TREACHEROUS AND HAVE BEEN KNOWN TO CHANGE VERY RAPIDLY, MOST OFTEN A CHANGE FOR THE WORST.

PENETRATION DIVES ON THE POLLING IS ANOTHER STORY ALL TOGETHER. AS WITH PENETRATION DIVES, THAT IS, A DIVE WHERE ACTUAL ENTRY INTO THE SHIP IS PLANNED. SPECIAL SAFETY EQUIPMENT AND PRECAUTIONS MUST BE USED.

ONCE GAINING ENTRY INTO THE STERN THROUGH ANY ONE OF THE FOUR HATCHES PRESENTLY OPEN, THE DIVER IS PRESENTED WITH HIS FIRST PROBLEM. WHERE AM I ? IS THIS THE GALLEY, ENGINE ROOM, OR JUST A COMPANIONWAY? IN THIS POSITION A WRONG TURN COULD MEAN THE END. THOUGH MOST THINGS INSIDE ARE EASILY RECOGNIZABLE AND IN PLACE, ONCE INSIDE MANY OF THE OBJECTS CAN COME LOOSE AND BECOME POTENTIAL DANGERS.

A GLANCE INSIDE THE PORT SIDE WILL SHOW A HALLWAY, OFF OF WHICH IS THE BERTHING ARE FOR THE CREW. THESE ARE "REASONABLY" CLEAN, THAT IS IF YOU DON'T MIND BLANKETS, MATTRESSES, BOXES, FURNITURE AND PERSONEL BELONGINGS FLOATING AROUND YOU. PERSONALLY I WOULDN'T RECOMMEND ENTRY INTO THEM UNLESS YOU ARE PROPERLY EQUIPPED AND HAVE ADEQUATE EXPERIENCE TO DO SO.

THE STARBOARD SIDE, ON THE OTHER HAND IS IN SHAMBLES. IF YOU CAN IMAGINE A HOUSE FLOODED WITH WATER AFTER HAVING BEEN THROUGH A WIND STORM AND AN EARTHQUAKE, EVEN THIS WOULDN'T BE AS BAD AS THE STARBOARD SIDE OF THE SHIP. ALL OF THE PLYWOOD CEILINGS HAVE COLLAPSED BRINGING WITH THEM ALL OF THE WIRING AND DUCTWORK. ENTRY INTO THIS SECTION IS ALMOST IMPOSSIBLE AND DEFINITELY SUICIDE. IF YOU COULD WIGGLE AND SQUEESE IN YOU WOULD CERTAINLY KICK UP THE SEDIMENT, THUS LOSING VISIBILITY, THUS INCREASING THE CHANCE OF GETTING TANGLED IN SOME UNSEEN OBJECT AND THUS DYING THERE. SOUND A LITTLE FAR FETCHED, IT'S NOT AT ALL. ONE GLANCE AND YOU'LL KNOW WHY YOU SHOULD STAY CLEAR OF THE AREA.

GOING BELOW INTO THE ENGINE ROOM IS A REAL THRILL, THE TWO BIG 1,080 H.P.-G.M.C. DEISEL ENGINES, GAUGES, CONTROLS, TOOLS, JUST THE WAY THEY WERE ON HER FINAL VOYAGE. I MIGHT ADD HERE THAT THE ABOVE MENTIONED ITEMS ARE PRESENTLY LOCATED IN THE TOOL BOXES AND HOMES OF SOME OF THE SOUTH SHORE NEPTUNES MEMBERS.

~~INTEN~~ IN THE INTERIM OF FIVE MONTHS ON THE BOTTOM, THE INSIDE OF THE WRECK IS PILING UP WITH SILT AND WORSENING WITH EACH DIVE. ESPECIALLY IN THE ENGINE ROOM AND GALLEY THE SILT IS BECOMING A REAL PROBLEM.

AS WITH ANY SHIPWRECK OF THIS CALIBER SAFETY PRECAUTIONS ARE A MUST. AS TIME GOES ON INSIDE OF THE WRECK IT WILL BECOME MORE AND

MORE SILTED UP AND A SAFETY LINE WILL HAVE TO BE USED FOR PENETRATORS. PRESENTLY THE SAFETY EQUIPMENT NEEDED FOR A SAFE DIVE IS AT LEAST AN OCTUPUS RIG IF NOT A PONY BOTTLE, EXTRA FLASHLIGHTS, AND SOMETHING THAT HAS TO BE USED- A BUDDY SYSTEM.

ALL IN ALL THE CHESTER A. POLLINGIS PROBABLY ONE OF THE MOST UNIQUE SHIPWRECKS IN NEW ENGLAND. SHE IS ACCESSIBLE, CLEAN, AND LOADED WITH GOODIES. BUT DON'T LET IT HAPPEN TO YOU, THAT THIS DREAM COME TRUE SHIPWRECK TURN INTO A NIGHTMARE, USE THE PROPER EQUIPMENT, USE THE PROPER SAFETY EQUIPMENT AND PRECAUTIONS, USE A BUDDY SYSTEM AND DON'T EXCEED YOUR OWN PERSONAL CAPABILITIES. FINALLY RESPECT THE WRECK, APPROACH HERE WITH TOTAL AWARENESS OF THE DANGERS INVOLVED AND ENJOY YOUR DIVE.
